

6. The Project Coordinator agrees to advise the State at appropriate intervals of the progress of the project and, upon completion of the project, the Coordinator shall furnish the State, without charge, a duplicate original and a copy of the finished work product resulting from the project, including but not limited to, any and all project reports, photographs, sketches, drawings, paintings, motion pictures, moving images, videotapes or recordings, audiotapes or recordings, or any other object or image representing the likeness of any person, place, thing, or events in Pohnpei.
7. It is further agreed that the State shall have rights in and full authority to reproduce, publish, display or exhibit the finished work product of the project or any part thereof in any manner of the State's choosing.
8. In case of an Archaeological survey or investigation, Project Coordinator must submit a State nomination of non registered site to the Pohnpei Historic Preservation Office for registry of Historic places of Pohnpei State.
9. The project coordinator must submit a preliminary report before departing the island and A final report or product upon completion to the Office of Pohnpei Historic Preservation Office.
